The TD reserves the right to amalgamate age groups if there are insufficient entries to make a workable draw. Players are only allowed to enter one category.

U11 CATEGORIES

U11 categories are also played under ESF regulations
The U11 categories are not recognised for ranking purposes of ESF.

ELIGIBILITY

Any player shall be entitled to enter providing that he/she is under the age of 11/13/15/17/19/ (according to the category entered on the closing date of the tournament. As specified by the European Squash Federation; to compete in all ESF registered events, all players, coaches, managers and other officials must be registered with ESF. This must be approved and validated by the relevant MNF.

The MNF is responsible for ensuring that all players, coaches, managers and other officials are registered with ESF prior to entry, and their entry is fully supported.

COACHES

All team or individual player coaches designated by their Nation as part of their event onsite management team (solely or in attendance with an appointed team manager) at any Championship held under the auspices of ESF must be ESF registered, i.e. have an ESID, as their licence to attend as a formal representative. This is required at the time of them being registered to a tend by their National federation.

SEEDING

The seeding and draw will be carried out using the ESF rankings valid at the tournament closing date in accordance with the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines Section D

MATCHES

All matches played will consist of the best of five games, under the rules of the WSF. All players are guaranteed a minimum of three matches. PAR 11 scoring (to 2 clear points) will be used.













DRAWS

Maximum draw size: 64

REFEREEING

Both players will be expected to mark and referee matches.

CLOTHING

Players must wear suitable squash attire including non-marking shoes

EYE PROTECTION

It is mandatory for approved eye protection to be worn at all times during competition play, including the knock up at this event. Players will not be allowed to compete without approved eye protection

RECORDING OF MATCHES/WEB PUBLISHING/LIVE STREAMING

The recording of matches for coaching/performance analysis purposes is acceptable provided the player and/or their parents/coaches do not object.

The Junior Open will be publishing draws, results, photos of players as well as live streaming.

PRIZES AND OFFICIAL PHOTOS

Trophies in all categories for the Top 4. Diplomas for all participants. Exact prizes to be determined at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Medal ceremonies will be held individually for each category, right after the match for 3rd place. A group photo for all players will be taken on Saturday, November 8, 2025, at 2:00 PM.

INSURANCE

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor the ESF will accept responsibility for any claims including for injury or accident. Suitable insurance must be organised by the player or the participating federation.

ENTRIES

All entries must be endorsed by the players National Association.

HOTEL

Accommodation is provided for all purchased Hotel & Food or Accompanying packages.

The number of hotel packages is limited.

Accommodation details (number of nights, room type, etc.) are arranged individually via email with each group/person.

When purchasing a hotel package, the buyer is responsible for selecting the number of nights and the room type. Changes to the tournament schedule (e.g. reducing match days from 4 to 3, depending on the number of participants) do not automatically change the number of reserved nights and do not guarantee a refund if the player shortens their hotel stay. The buyer is fully responsible for the choice of package.

The organizer reserves the right to add additional accommodation facilities if needed.

The hotel is located 10-15 minutes on foot from our sports venue. There will be NO shuttle bus between TOURNAMENT HOTEL and HASTA LA VISTA CLUB.

All available rooms are twin rooms (one person will have a bed, and a sofa with a mattress will be arranged and made up for the second person the sofa is only 5 cm smaller than the bed).













TRANSPORT

There will be no official transportation, as the airport will be closed during the event and therefore no airport pick-up or drop-off service will be available.

The official hotel is located within walking distance of the venue (approx. 15 minutes on foot).

The main train station is well connected to the part of the city where both Hasta la Vista and Hotel Element are located.

For this reason, the organizer has decided that it is more economical to exclude transportation costs from the hotel package.

CATERING

Meals will be provided for all purchased Hotel & Food / Food / Accompanying packages. Players and supporters with pre-paid packages will receive their meals after presenting the tournament ID card received during registration.

Meals will also be available for purchase on-site during the tournament. Payments will be accepted in cash and by card (PLN/EUR). Catering opening hours will be published closer to the event.

REGISTRATION

Each player must register and collect their ID, and T-shirt (if purchased) before their first match. Only the appropriate ID entitles the holder to use services included in the package, such as meals.

Registration opening hours will be published closer to the event.

PRACTICE COURTS

7-9 November

On these days, all event courts* will be available for practice starting 1 hour before the matches begin (e.g., if matches start at 09:00, courts will be available from 08:00).

During the event days, players can use all available courts for practice at no charge, but courts cannot be prebooked. Access to the glass court is managed by TD Tomas Hraszky: email: thrazsky@gmail.com, WhatsApp: +48 698 437 762.

*Event courts = courts used on a particular day for event matches.

Extra access to the courts requires payment according to the standard prices: Hasta La Vista Pricing. If you are interested in an individual reservation requiring payment, you can book the court in advance via pjo@hastalavista.pl or at the reception desk upon arrival at Hasta La Vista.

CANCELLATIONS OF ENTRIES

- Withdrawal up to 14 days before the start date of a tournament: fees reimbursed in full (less bank charges).
- Withdrawal 3-14 days before the start date of a tournament: 50% of fees reimbursed (less bank charges)
- Withdrawal 2 days or less before the start date of a tournament: reimbursement at the discretion of the tournament organiser

In case of withdrawal, fees will be reimbursed according to ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines, section E.

CANCELLATIONS OF HOTEL PACKAGES

- Cancellation of hotel reservations after confirmation by the organizer is subject solely to the hotel's policies. **Refunds are not guaranteed**, even if the package cancellation is submitted within the deadline for tournament withdrawal with full entry fee refund.
- Obtaining the visa is the sole responsibility of the players. In case of visa denial, if the hotel package has already been purchased, **refunds are not guaranteed**.
- Any expenses already incurred by the organizer (e.g. hotel deposits, booking fees) will **not be refunded**.
- Failure to make payment on time will result in automatic cancellation of the package.

VISA APPLICATION

If players need to apply for a visa, they can apply for a confirmation letter from the Polish Squash Association. Players can acquire a confirmation letter upon request.

Please take the following guidelines into account when visas are needed:

Before applying for a letter a player must register for entry of the Polish Junior Open 2024.

Before a letter is sent, a payment must have been received.

Before a letter is sent, the organization must receive the following necessary information:

- Full Name
- Date of Birth (DD-MM-YY):
- Place of Birth
- Passport number
- Date of Expriy
- Date of arrival
- Date of departure

Receiving a letter from the Polish Junior Open can take up to 5 working days after the registration, payment, and necessary information have been received.

Obtaining the visa is the responsibility of the players. If the visa gets denied after the entry deadline, players will only be able to get a refund according to the rules for cancellations as written above.

EVALUATION

A link to an online survey will be sent to all participants after the tournament has taken place. Responses are anonymous and will be collated by the ESF office.

SAFEGUARDING, HEALTH AND SAFETY

Adults interacting with juniors in the organisation and running of ESF Junior Circuit events are in a position of trust and influence. They should always ensure that junior players are treated with

integrity and respect. Tournaments should be run in a safe, positive and encouraging atmosphere. The Tournament Director and Tournament Referee should be trained in safeguarding children according to the host MNF national standards for child protection.

The health and safety of all persons (players, officials, spectators, tournament staff) involved in or attending a tournament is of paramount importance. The host MNF is responsible for ensuring an appropriate plan is in place for the tournament.













ESF REGULATIONS & PENALTIES

The tournament is part of the ESF Junior Circuit and will be run in accordance with the ESF Junior Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website www.europeansquash.com. MNFs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements.

The tournament will be run under the terms and conditions as set out in ESF Regulations: Code of Conduct - The tournament will be run under the terms and conditions as set out in EUROPEAN SQUASH FEDERATION PRIVACY POLICY as published on the ESF website www.europeansquash.com

A late withdrawal is a withdrawal made 2 days or less before the start date of the tournament. Ranking penalties may be applied to the records of the players who fail to turn up or who make a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate.

Please note: The medical certificate must clearly state the players name, date of birth and nature of the illness/injury the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournamnet and must be sent to the ESF Office within 2 days after the final day of the tournament.

If a player:

- Has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament
- Fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she may receive zero ranking points for the tournament
- If zero points are awarded the points will count as one of the players 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically
- Commits either of these offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Juniors Circuit for a period of 12 months.
